

UAYSL – COVID-19 Mitigation Plan – Outdoor Play – Roles/Responsibilities

<p>Distribute UAYSL COVID-19 Mitigation Plan for Outdoor Play to all member Clubs & current session participating team coaches & managers. Also post on website.</p> <p>UAYSL will adhere to current MOA Emergency Orders, Facility Mitigation Guidelines, AYSA Mitigation Guidelines & AYSA COVID-19 Reporting Procedures.</p> <p>Ensure UAYSL Ref Assignor & referees receive the UAYSL Mitigation Plan for Outdoor Play.</p> <p>UAYSL COVID-19 protocols and best practices signage will be placed at venues if required.</p> <p>Games at the same venue will have 25-40 minute breaks between consecutive games to allow for less crowded transitions. Teams must exit the field immediately at the conclusion of the game. Teams must not congregate at the entrance/exit of facilities and fields. Maintain 6ft social distance at all times, with the exception of during game play.</p> <p>Portable toilets with hand sanitizer and will be provided at game venues.</p>	<p>Review & follow UAYSL & AYSA COVID Mitigation Plan for Outdoor Play and all Facility Mitigation Plans.</p> <p>Complete AYSA COVID-19 Health Status Agreement Form and send to Referee Assignor. Done once per soccer year.</p> <p>If referees are experiencing any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 they are required to notify the assignor immediately, and voluntarily remove self from all assignments.</p> <p>Referee should use hand sanitizer before and after each game, have a personal supply of sanitizer, disinfecting wipes and gloves. Face masks are recommended at all times; before, during and after games.</p> <p>Use only own equipment and set bag apart from others.</p> <p>Referee should allow, when possible, to remain ten (10) feet from all game participants for social distancing prior, during and after the game.</p> <p>Rosters are electronic.</p> <p>Electronic whistles are recommended. If regular whistle is used, attempt to not blow within ten (10) feet of individuals.</p> <p>No pre-game coin toss. Home team chooses direction. No pre/post game handshakes or celebrations.</p>	<p>Distribute & post UAYSL COVID-19 Mitigation Plan for Outdoor Play.</p> <p>Ensure all players have submitted a signed AYSA COVID-19 Health Screening & Release form to be kept on file for the remainder of the current soccer year.</p> <p>Clubs are required to certify, in writing to UAYSL, that all club players participating in league games have submitted a signed AYSA COVID-19 Health Screening & Release form and said forms are on file.</p> <p>Team rosters must be electronic, accurate for each individual game, kept on file and available to opposing coaches, managers, referees, UAYSL & AYSA for the entire current Indoor session.</p> <p>Train and educate all club & team staff/volunteers on UAYSL, AYSA & Facility COVID-19 Return-to-Play Mitigation Plans and guidelines.</p> <p>Provide teams with sanitation supplies and appropriate masks. Masks must have at least two layers and cover both nose and mouth. Thin mesh masks are not allowed. If disposable surgical type masks are used, the second layer liner may not be removed.</p>	<p>Review & follow the AYSA & UAYSL COVID-19 Mitigation Plans for Outdoor Play and all Facility Mitigation Plans.</p> <p>Screen self & all players prior to the start of each game. Ensure safe isolation of any unwell player and notify parent/guardian immediately.</p> <p>Keep a log of specific staff & player attendance for each game. This must be available, in electronic format, upon request if needed for contact tracing.</p> <p>Team rosters must be paperless, accurate for each game, and available to opposing coaches, managers and referees electronically.</p> <p>Ensure teams are instructed on social distancing recommendation of 6ft separation while entering/exiting the parking lot, during warm-up, and while on the sidelines. No team benches. Team sidelines must be across the field from each other, either directly or diagonally. Physical contact is only permitted within the rules of soccer during time of active game play.</p> <p>Instruct, monitor and ensure players avoid sharing equipment or touch any training or field equipment. Sanitize team equipment before and after each game.</p>	<p>Review & follow the AYSA & UAYSL COVID-19 Mitigation Plans for Outdoor Play and all game facility Mitigation Plans.</p> <p>If player is sick, feeling sick, has been exposed to a person with COVID-19 or if player, parent or household member is an at-risk individual STAY HOME.</p> <p>Player must bring own equipment & water bottle to games. Player should not share water, food or equipment.</p> <p>Player should wash/sanitize hands before, during & after games. Bringing own sanitizer is recommended.</p> <p>Masks are recommended for players & when entering/exiting the game facility and at all times when at the game facility, including during game play.</p> <p>Currently, spectators are allowed at UAYSL league games. Masks and 6ft social distances are recommended at all times</p> <p>Player hugs, high 5's, handshakes, knuckles or physical contact group celebrations are not allowed. No spitting. Deliberate coughing at or on a game participant will result in an immediate red card for the offending player.</p>

<p>Rosters will be electronic. Teams must adhere to the UAYSL Electronic Roster Procedure distributed to coaches & managers and posted on the UAYSL website.</p> <p>Per AYSA policy, Referees have the authority to terminate a game if a participating team does not adhere to the required COVID-19 Mitigation protocols of UAYSL, AYSA, MOA and the Facility. Game termination due to a team's failure to adhere will result in a forfeit for the offending team (including the applicable UAYSL forfeit penalty fee) and a fine to the Club by AYSA.</p> <p>UAYSL Point-of-Contact: Sonna Lyle UAYSL Administrator uaysl.info@yahoo.com 440-2547</p> <p>AYSA Outdoor Mitigation Guidelines</p> <p>AYSA COVID Reporting Procedure</p>	<p>Deliberate coughing at or on any match participant by any player will result in an immediate red card.</p> <p>It is not the referee's role to enforce UAYSL, AYSA or Facility COVID-19 Mitigation requirements. Referees are to note and report instances of non-compliance to the UAYSL Referee Assignor. Referee Assignor is required to report all instances to UAYSL and AYSA immediately. However, the Head Referee is authorized to terminate a game if a team is in non-compliance per AYSA policy.</p>	<p>Clubs are required to follow the AYSA COVID-19 Reporting Procedures if a player is diagnosed with COVID-19, has reported symptoms or was exposed to a person with COVID-19. Clubs must provide immediately, upon request, applicable team roster for any games in which said player/s participated and current contact information for applicable rosters. Must be provided electronically.</p> <p>Streaming Games – teams may bring one individual to record the game. Individual is not allowed on the team sideline if two team staff are already present, per AYSA policy. This individual must be included on the team roster in the team staff section as one of the 4 technical staff allowed on the roster, per AYSA policy. If the individual is 18 years or over, must be currently registered with AYSA, passed the background check and current with SafeSport. Individual must adhere to all UAYSL and AYSA mitigation plans and all facility mitigation plans.</p>	<p>Ensure team staff and players adhere to the mask policy for each venue location. Masks are recommended for team staff and players when entering/exiting all game facilities and at all times when at each game facility, including during game play. Appropriate masks must have at least a two-layer thickness and cover both nose and mouth. Thin mesh masks are not recommended. If disposable surgical type masks are used, the second layer liner should not be removed. Any player, team staff or referee who desires to wear a mask at any time must be allowed to do so.</p> <p>Ensure teams do not access warm-up area (if provided) or game field area until the previous group has fully vacated.</p> <p>Ensure teams leave the field immediately after the conclusion of each game to improve social distancing during transition times. Teams must follow specific game field & facility enter/exit traffic flow pattern requirements for each individual game facility. Ensure teams follow social distancing guidelines and do not crowd together when entering and exiting the game field and/or warm-up areas.</p> <p>Teams traveling to participate in a UAYSL session, from outside of the Anchorage/Matsu areas, must submit a COVID-19 travel plan to the AYSA Executive Director for approval prior to initiating travel.</p>	<p>Limiting carpooling to only members of the same household is recommended.</p> <p>Parent to notify Club point-of-contact representative immediately if player becomes ill for any reason or was exposed to a person with COVID-19.</p>
