

UAYSL Game Protest Procedure

A game may be protested due to roster and eligible player violations of the UAYSL Rules of Competition only. Referee calls and decisions are final and may not be protested.

Protest Procedure

1. A written protest statement and \$50 protest fee must be submitted to the UAYSL Administrator within 3 business days of the game in question. Submission of statement may be via email or by US mail. If protest statement is submitted via US mail, it must be postmarked within 3 business days of the game in question. The protest fee must be mailed and postmarked within 3 days of the game in question.
2. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is granted.
3. The UAYSL Administrator will notify the accused party of the complaint and will allow 3 business days to provide a written response to the official complaint (The official response may be in the form of an email or letter. An email response must be received within the 3 day timeframe; a letter must be postmarked the same.) From that documentation, and the original protest statement, the UAYSL Administrator shall make his/her final decision. The UAYSL Administrator may request additional information as needed. Failure of the accused party to respond will result in the forfeiture of their right to appeal.
4. The UAYSL Administrator will take action on all properly reported complaints.
5. Final disciplinary decisions of the UAYSL Administrator may be appealed to the UAYSL Board of Directors per the UAYSL Bylaws.
