*16-U and older teams with a 22 player roster may only dress 18 players for each game.

**The Federation is recommending new rules as it relates to heading, as follows:

Players in 11-U programs and younger shall not engage in heading, either in practices or in games.

Limited heading in practice for players in 12-U and 13-U programs.

Specifically, these players shall be limited to a max of 30 minutes of heading training per week, with no more than 15-20 headers per player, per week.

Clubs should be aware of circumstances in which individual consideration is needed. For example:

A 10 year old playing at 12-U or older should not head the ball at all.

An 11 or 12 year old playing at 14-U or older should abide by the heading restrictions in practice.

When a player deliberately heads the ball in a game, an indirect free kick (IFK) should be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense.

If the deliberate header occurs within the goal area, the indirect free kick should be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the point nearest to where the infringement occurred. If a player does not deliberately head the ball, then play should continue.
