

## **2016 UAYSL Fall Cup - General Information**

**November 25, 26, 27, 2016 - (3 GAME DAYS/Friday-Sunday)**

Boys & Girls

6U ('11) & 8U ('09) Recreational Co-ed – 4v4 - \$190

9U ('08) thru 14U ('03) Competitive – 7v7 - \$330

15U/19U ('02-'98) High School Premier Combined – 6v6 - \$350

1. **Registration Online:** Team registration will be online only; you can register your team at [www.uaysl.org](http://www.uaysl.org) Registration must be completed and fees paid on or before midnight on **Wednesday, November 16, 2016**. Registration without the entry fee will be considered incomplete, and will not be processed. No refunds will be given after **November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016**.
2. **Eligible Teams:** The following age groups are eligible to participate in the 2016 UAYSL Fall Cup Tournament. All players must be AYSA affiliated.

### **Co-Ed Teams:**

6U and 8U

### **Boys & Girls Teams:**

9U through 14U

15U/19U Combined Division

**Note: We will try to create single age divisions but if less than (4) teams register in an age group we will combine those with (1) age division up.**

3. **Credentials Check:** At The Dome on Friday, November 25<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am, ONE (1) hour prior to the start of games at 10:00am. Please bring a current registration form for each player which includes a signed and dated medical release statement (USYSA or your club's equivalent), clear copy of player birth certificate and at least THREE (3) copies of the final team roster (we will stamp them as official & we keep one copy); we suggest you bring a copy for each game. Final rosters must match the rosters received during team online registration with the following exception: **Teams may add up to THREE (3) age appropriate guest players – guest players must have all required paperwork AND all AYSA registered players must have a signed AYSA Single Event Guest Player Permission Form; guest players from recreational teams are not required to submit the Guest Player Form. Rosters are frozen after credentials check.**
4. **Rosters:**

Team rosters can be updated online on or before November 23rd; just log in to your account, make your changes, and update your roster. After November 23rd, teams will be required to submit a hard copy with their changes to the Tournament Committee at credentials check on November 25<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am. Players may not be added for any reason after credentials check – rosters are frozen once your team has completed credentials check. Any player whose paperwork has not been cleared with the Tournament committee prior to your team's first game is ineligible to play at any time during the tournament. **Please Note:** We will use the roster provided with registration for Tournament garment imprints. Rosters and roster corrections received after the final registration deadline (Nov. 12<sup>th</sup>) and at credentials will not be included for imprint on the Tournament garments. Players **may not** be dual rostered.

### Roster Requirements

6U & 8U                      Maximum 6, minimum 4 (co-ed)

9U – 14U                      Maximum 14, minimum 8

15U/19U Combined      Maximum 12, minimum 7

*\*6U & 8U will have a (4) game minimum, 9U and up will have a (3) game minimum.*

5. **Preliminary Schedules:** Preliminary schedules will be posted on the website when they are available. If you don't see the schedule on the website, it is not ready! Final schedules will be distributed at credentials check on November 25th.
6. **Awards:** Awards for 1st & 2nd places will be presented by Tournament officials immediately following completion of the championship games for the 9U through 15U/19U divisions. Please gather your teams at the headquarters at the conclusion of these games for award presentations. All 6U & 8U team players will each receive a participation award.
7. **Scoring:**

Win = 3 points  
Tie = 1 point  
Loss = 0 points

Only a (4) point maximum differential will be recorded in any match  
*i.e. Red Team (10) vs Blue Team (2) will be recorded as Red (6), Blue (2)*

### **Point Tie Breakers:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Head to head
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Fewest total goals by common opponents
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Most total goals scored against common opponents
- 4<sup>th</sup> Fewest Cards (yellow = 1, red = 3)
- 5<sup>th</sup> Coin toss
